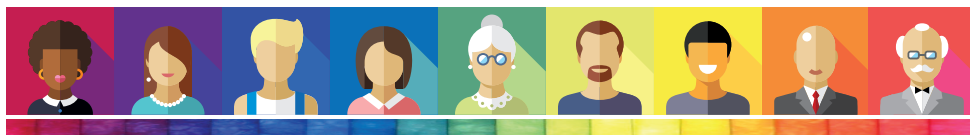

This course is a unique opportunity for those moving into leadership and management roles, or who are already in those roles, to have support on that journey from experienced senior leaders in NHS audiology. There is no other similar course in our profession, or in physiological sciences, where senior clinicians come together to share their knowledge of leading audiology teams. The feedback from attendees on the course has consistently been outstanding.

Anne Davies was awarded the Denzil Brooks Trophy in 2010 from the British Society of Audiology for setting up this course. The course provides practical skills on all aspects of running audiology services. The programme explores leadership qualities, communication skills, leading a team, business planning, change management, service development, clinical governance, stress management, and current issues in Audiology. The course faculty also discuss leadership in a post-covid world, and the approaches necessary to lead in this new more remote / virtual world.

The course gives time out to reflect on your skills and self-management, and there is opportunity to discuss with the speaker faculty in a relaxed setting. This is an exceptional opportunity to gain resources, tools and insights from key clinical leaders in audiology, who are motivated to pass on what has worked for them.

Accommodation and Travel

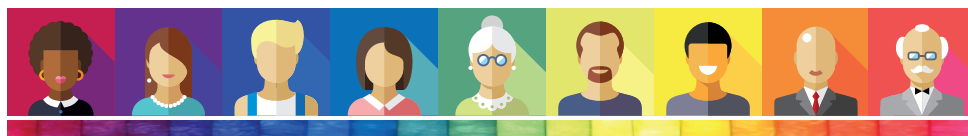
This is a non-residential course; delegates are responsible for booking their own accommodation. Accommodation costs are not included in the course fee.

The course venue is The Park Royal Hotel, Stretton Road, Stretton, Warrington WA4 4NS. This is on the outskirts of Warrington, a 15-20 min taxi ride from Warrington town centre. The Park Royal Hotel offers a discounted bed and breakfast rate for course attendees; please contact us for details.

The course fee includes evening meal on the Tuesday evening of the course at 6.30pm. On Wednesday evening, please make your own arrangements for evening meal.

Driving into and out of Warrington can be subject to considerable delay during rush-hour. We therefore recommend staying over, rather than driving daily to the course. Where the latter is unavoidable, please leave plenty of time for your journey.

Leaving the course early on the final afternoon is not advised. Train travel from the Warrington stations should be booked for no earlier than 4.00pm.

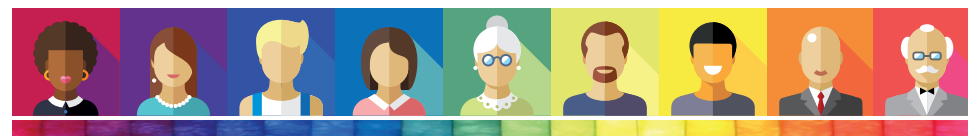
